WHEREAS, the MCDC Board of Directors reserves the right to revise, supplement, or rescind any policies or portions of the MCDC Operating Manual from time to time;

WHEREAS, Resolution 2022-02 RELATING TO CHANGES TO THE OPERATING MANUAL grants the Board of Directors the authority to issue supplemental changes or updates to the Operating Manual outside a full update to the manual;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:


When openings for children occur at the MCDC, Admission shall be offered to eligible children in the following priority order:

| First Priority: | Siblings of currently enrolled Marshall Space Flight Center (MSFC) government and contractor children |
| Second Priority: | Siblings of currently enrolled Redstone Family children |
| Third Priority: | Dependents of full-time MCDC employees |
| Fourth Priority: | Dependents of MSFC government employees |
| Fifth Priority: | Dependents of MSFC contractor employees |
| Sixth Priority: | Dependents of Redstone Family employees |
| Seventh Priority: | Grandchildren of MSFC employees |
| Eighth Priority: | Dependents of MSFC retirees |

At no time will a change in enrollment priorities result in the removal of currently enrolled children from MCDC.

This resolution supersedes any previous resolutions on this matter.
